CALLED TO ORDER – SECRETARY CLAIRE DEMATTEIS, DHR

Secretary DeMatteis called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – SECRETARY CLAIRE DEMATTEIS, DHR

A MOTION was made by Commissioner Navarro and seconded by Shaun O'Brien to approve the minutes from the August 21, 2023 meeting of the State Employee Benefits Committee, with one correction regarding the vote on the GHIP Budget at the October 23, 2023 meeting MOTION ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT – DIRECTOR FAITH RENTZ, SBO

Director Rentz provided Committee members with agenda items from this morning's Financial Subcommittee and Health Policy & Planning Subcommittee meetings. Additionally, the upcoming Retiree Healthcare Benefits Advisory Subcommittee (RHBAS) meeting will be held at the Department of Insurance on September 27 at 1:30 p.m.

Director Cade arrived to the meeting.

FINANCIALS - BRIAN STITZEL, WTW

Revised June 2023 GHIP Fund Report

Brian Stitzel reviewed a revised June Fund Report to update the actual year-to-date claim liability and minimum reserves.

July 2023 Fund Report

Brian Stitzel detailed the July Fund Report and reviewed a new exhibit that includes an executive summary and more detailed information on premium contributions, other revenues, claims, and expenses.

Premium contributions (\$78.3M) and other revenues (2.5M) were slightly over budget with claims (\$88M) and expenses (\$4M) under budget. Total costs for the month were \$2.8M less than budget at a deficit of \$11.3M.

SEBC Dashboard

Brian Stitzel presented the SEBC dashboard which pulled data from the key trends report to analyze trends in cost and utilization of healthcare. The dashboard displays trends on active employees and early retirees based on

utilization and unit cost from the most recent 12 months through July 2023 compared to the previous 12 months through July 2022.

Jaclyn Iglesias provided utilization data on weight loss medications with the year-to-date actual cost of \$1.27M for the first 2.5 months of the plan year and the original FY24 cost estimate was \$1.78M for the plan year. Utilization is currently 70% of original cost estimates.

Treasurer Davis arrived to the meeting.

UPDATE ON MEDICARE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) - JACLYN IGLESIAS, WTW

Jaclyn Iglesias discussed updates for the Medicare RFP which will solicit bids for a Medicare Supplement plan for current and future retirees that is substantially equivalent in design as the current Special Medicfill Medicare Supplement plan. A review of the requested scope of services and current RFP timeline was presented.

EXTENSION OF SPECIAL MEDICFILL PLANS THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024 – SECRETARY CLAIRE DEMATTEIS, DHR

A MOTION was made by Commissioner Navarro and seconded by Secretary Manning that pursuant to Delaware Code, Title 29, Section 6907b (Emergency procedures and critical need for professional services) there is a critical need and to hereby waive the requirement of the States procurement code and extend the Special Medicfill contract with Highmark through December 31, 2024.

MOTION ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

PUBLIC COMMENT

A co-vice chair of the RHBAS provided public comment on discussions and recommendations of the RHBAS related to the Medicare RFP. Members of the public provided comment on continued concerns related to Medicare Advantage and commented on Agenda items discussed on today's meeting specifically related to the Medicare RFP.
