CALLED TO ORDER - LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR BETHANY HALL-LONG

Lieutenant Governor Hall-Long called the meeting to order at 10:04 A.M.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR BETHANY HALL-LONG

A MOTION was made by Representative Baumbach and seconded by Wayne Emsley to approve the minutes from the Retiree Healthcare Benefits Advisory Subcommittee meeting on July 10, 2023 after discussion and modifications.

MOTION ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

Director Cade arrived to the meeting.

DISCUSSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF OPEB FUNDING, ELIGIBILITY, AND PLAN DESIGN

Medicare Supplemental Plan Design Options – Chris Giovannello & Jaclyn Iglesias, WTW

Jaclyn Iglesias and Chris Giovannello reviewed a comparison of the Special Medicfill plan design versus several individual Medicare Supplement plan designs found in the marketplace. An example was provided on medical plan options for Medicare retirees after 1/1/2025 which depicts two Medicare Supplement plan designs mirrored after individual Medigap plans and included a 10th, 50th, and 90th percentile comparison of retiree costs.

OPEB Modeling Options - Lieutenant Governor Hall-Long & Secretary Geisenberger, DOF

Lieutenant Governor Hall-Long discussed funding options and another example of a combination of funding, eligibility, and benefit design options to reduce the OPEB liability.

Secretary Geisenberger provided an analysis of the projected net cost of retiree healthcare benefits without any changes to design or eligibility and the impact on the trust fund.

Subcommittee members continued a robust discussion on Medicare retiree options to reduce the OPEB Liability.

A MOTION was made by Wayne Emsley and seconded by Representative Baumbach to set the 2052 OPEB funded ratio target at a minimum of 80% and no requirement to reach the actuarially defined contribution. Disapprovals – Secretary Geisenberger, Director Cade

Abstentions – Secretary DeMatteis
