#### **Notable Trends**

Among non-participating groups<sup>2</sup>, for the current incurred rolling year period (April 1, 2017 – March 31, 2018) compared to the prior incurred rolling year period (April 1, 2016 – March 31, 2017):

- Total net payments for medical and drug claims increased by 5.3% to \$680 million. The increase was driven by a \$24.9 million (5.6%) increase in medical payments that included an \$8.8 million (8.1%) increase in medical payments among high cost claimants (HCCs). Net payments for chemotherapy among HCCs increased by \$4.2 million or 73.7 percent. There was also a sizeable increase (36.9%) in drug spending among HCCs.
- A large portion of the increase in the medical payments trend was attributable to outpatient facility claims (an increase of \$21.5 million and a 16.2% trend). Outpatient surgery payments increased by 10.4% and emergency room payments increased by 14.3 percent.
- Among the top 20 physician specialties in terms of total net payments, the trends were generally downward or stable, however net payments markedly increased for emergency medicine (19.7%), pathology (15.1%), orthopaedic surgery (9.6%) and rheumatology (7.5%) during the current rolling year. The service trend for oncology declined by 14.2 percent.
- Payments for inpatient facility claims decreased by 3.2% from \$170 PEPM to \$165 PEPM with corresponding decreases in utilization for surgical and medical services. Payments for inpatient maternity claims increased by 12% despite a 10.3% decrease in utilization.
- Musculoskeletal conditions including osteoarthritis, arthropathies and joint disorders and spinal and back disorders continued to be among the top clinical conditions in terms of total net payments. Other top clinical conditions in terms of net payments included pregnancy related conditions and gastrointestinal disorders.
- Utilization of urgent care facilities increased by 5.9% (from 444.4 visits per 1,000 to 470.4 visits per 1,000) and net payments PEPM for urgent care services increased by from \$5.74 to \$6.56 (16.3%) during the current rolling year.
  Utilization of emergency rooms for services that could be provided in an urgent care setting decreased by 3.8 percent.
  PEPM payments for these visits increased by 6.1% from \$19.49 to \$20.33 during the current rolling year.
- Utilization of high tech radiology decreased during the current rolling year period at outpatient hospital facilities by 2.9 percent. However, payments increased from \$19 PEPM to \$23 PEPM at these facilities.





# Net Pay Per Employee Per Month (PEPM) and Utilization Trends by Service Category for Last 12 Quarters






















#### Glossary
