135TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY HOUSE BILL NO. 604

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE BY PROVIDING FOR EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, in the name of service, State employees have made great

contributions to every aspect of life in the State of Delaware serving in the Legislative, Executive, and

Judicial branches of government; and

WHEREAS, the effectiveness, efficiency and quality of State

government depends in large measure on its employees who provide such a broad range of services that few citizens remain unaffected by their

work; and

WHEREAS, the importance of public services rendered by State

employees and the exemplary manner of their performance

are too often forgotten and ignored; and

WHEREAS, that the Statewide Labor-Management Committee has

recommended that State take proactive steps to recognize

dedication, talents and contributions made by State

Employees at all levels of government; and

WHEREAS. the Recognition Umbrella Committee has developed

procedures and guidelines for statewide and agency level

employee recognition initiatives,

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend Chapter 59, Title 29 of the Delaware Code by adding thereto a new Section 5950 to read as follows:

§5950. Employee Recognition.

- (a) It shall be part of the function of State agencies to conduct employee recognition programs for Merit System employees and employees in positions that are assigned to comparable Merit System classes or pay grades. All such Employee recognition programs shall be approved by the State Personnel Director prior to implementation.
- (b) The first full week in May shall be designated Public Service Recognition Week. Employee recognition Programs shall not, however, be confined to this week.

This bill was passed by the House on June 26, 1990, by the Senate on September 25, 1990 and signed into law by Governor Michael N. Castle on October 15, 1990.





About the Awards

Delaware Award for Excellence and Commitment in State Service

Established in 1990, this award recognizes up to five individuals or small groups (up to five employees) for their outstanding accomplishments, contributions, and performance in state service. This recognition may be based on the results of a one-time special act, outstanding service or accomplishment, or sustained excellence over time. Many nominees for this statewide award are selected from the Employees of the Year within their agencies.

GEAR P3 Trailblazer Award

This award, inspired by the Governor's Team Excellence Award, honors individual employees or teams of up to five state employees for work on projects that enhance government efficiency. Recipients are recognized not only for using continuous quality tools to achieve excellent outcomes but also for developing innovative designs and processes, establishing best practices, and producing sustainable results that can be adapted to other areas of government.

Governor's Team Excellence Awards

The Governor's Team Excellence Award Program was created to recognize and encourage teamwork and collaboration within state government. It is presented to teams of up to 20 state employees who have demonstrated excellence by working together and using continuous improvement tools to deliver superior customer service, improve work processes, reduce costs, and discover innovative ways of doing business. The program has two levels of recognition: Champions Award and the GEAR P3 Innovation and Efficiency Award.

Champions Award

This award recognizes teams that demonstrate a superior level of knowledge and use of continuous quality improvement tools and techniques. They must also have produced tangible results that lead to significant increases in efficiency, customer satisfaction, and/or cost savings.

GEAR P3 Innovation & Efficiency Award

This award recognizes teams with the highest levels of performance excellence and is sponsored through a public-private partnership (P3) initiative. It honors teams that not only use continuous improvement techniques to achieve excellent outcomes but also develop innovative designs and processes, establish best practices, and produce verifiable results that are sustainable, scalable, and adaptable to other areas of government. These teams serve as clear role models for other organizations.

About the Awards (Cont.)

Delaware Award for Heroism

This award recognizes acts of heroism and courage that go above and beyond the call of duty. Recipients of this award must have demonstrated outstanding judgment, exceptional courage, extraordinary decisiveness and presence of mind, and unusual swiftness of action, regardless of their own personal safety, in the attempt to save or protect human life and/or property.
